EVERY SCRUTINEER MUST HAVE AN APPOINTMENT FORM SIGNED BY A CANDIDATE

No candidate shall have more than one Scrutineer at a time at any voting station.

A Scrutineer must:

1. Bring this Appointment form to the Voting Station.
2. Show the form to the Deputy Returning Officer.
3. Receive a Scrutineer Badge from the Deputy Returning Officer.
4. If you are leaving the poll and are to be placed by another Scrutineer, give your Scrutineer Badge to that person.

A Scrutineer may:

1. Be in the polling station 15 minutes before the poll opens, during polling hours and until the counting of votes at the poll is completed.
2. Examine the ballot box before voting begins.
3. Challenge any person believed not to be a qualified voter or believed to have already voted, or to be impersonating a voter.
4. Sign the statement of the poll and all seals and envelopes as a witness to proper closing and sealing.
5. If present at the close of the poll, observe the ballot papers during the count, object to any ballots considered irregular and have those objections recorded in the poll book.

A Scrutineer may not:

1. Identify himself or herself to a voter as representing a particular candidate.
2. Attempt to influence voters or to reveal how any voter voted or intends to vote.
3. Campaign at the poll.
4. Argue with the Deputy Returning Officer (DRO) or Poll Clerk about the operation of the poll. The DRO's decision is final in all aspects.
5. Disrupt the proceedings of the poll in any manner.
6. If present for the counting of ballots, scrutineers must remain in the counting room until all ballots have been counted. Should a Scrutineer leave the room, he or she will **NOT** be permitted to re-enter while counting proceeds. A Scrutineer cannot enter the counting room once counting has commenced.
7. A Scrutineer may not use a cellular phone in the voting station.
